

## BYLAW 2014-04

### A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF HERBERT TO ESTABLISH SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING COLLECTION SERVICES AND RATES

THE COUNCIL OF THE Town of Herbert, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

#### PART 1 – SHORT TITLE

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the Town of Herbert Solid Waste and Recycling Management Bylaw

#### PART 2 – DEFINITIONS

2. In this Bylaw:

**“CAO” or “Administrator”** shall refer to the Chief Administrative Office of the Town of Herbert;

**“Council”** shall refer to the Council of the Town of Herbert;

**“Municipality”** shall refer to the Town of Herbert;

**“Property”** shall mean a parcel of land located within the boundaries of the Town of Herbert and on which a building or buildings (commercial or residential) may or may not be situated, whether such buildings are occupied or unoccupied.

#### PART 3 – PURPOSE

3. The purpose of this Bylaw is to set out management policies and rates specific to waste and recycling collection services within the boundaries of the Town of Herbert.

#### PART 4 – REQUIREMENT FOR PARTICIPATION

4. All residences shall be provided with one garbage cart (grey) and one recycling cart (blue). Any damage occurring to the bin shall be charged to the owner in accordance with the general conditions of the Cart Service Agreement with Triways Disposal Services, a copy of which is attached as Schedule “A”.
5. All business properties shall be allowed a choice of the size of waste container they wish to have on their premises and shall be charged according to the chosen size and number of containers.

6. All waste collection shall happen every other week, and all recycling collection shall happen every other week. These will be on alternating weeks.
7. All residents are required to participate in the Triways Disposal Services agreement with the Town of Herbert.
8. Any businesses not participating in the Triways Disposal Services agreement with the Town of Herbert shall keep their properties free from accumulation of all refuse, trade litter, cans, old tires, and all waste by removing same regularly to the Swift Current landfill or to recycling agencies.

#### PART 5 – MONTHLY FEES

9. Monthly fees shall be reviewed regularly by Council and shall reflect any increase in fees set by the contractor. These figures shall be based on a review of the previous year's rates by Administration.
10. Fees shall be based on the amounts set out in Schedule "B" attached and shall be include in the monthly Utility Billing.

#### PART 6 – INTEREST ON UNPAID ACCOUNTS

11. A 2% interest charge shall be added on the first day of each month to unpaid balances on accounts.

#### PART 7 – REPEAL PREVIOUS BYLAW

12. Bylaw 2005-05 is hereby repealed.

#### PART 8 – COMING INTO FORCE AND EFFECT

13. This bylaw shall come into force upon adoption by Council and the rates shall be effective the first billing following approval of the bylaw.

**APPENDIX “B” TO BYLAW 2014-04  
TOWN OF HERBERT**

**Fee Schedule for Collection, Removal or Disposal of Solid Wastes or Other Refuse**

Rates per monthly billing period as follows:

**\$11.00** for each serviced residential property plus \$5.50 for each extra bin they request

**\$11.00** for each serviced Church property plus \$5.50 for each extra bin they request

**\$13.50** for each serviced commercial property plus \$6.75 for each extra bin they request

**100%** of the bill for large containers from Triways for each of the following properties:

- Herbert & District Integrated Facility
- Herbert Heritage Manor
- Herbert Housing Authority
- Herbert School
- Pioneer Co-op

**75%** of the bill for large containers from Triways for each of the following properties:

- Herbert Machining
- Herbert Family Restaurant
- Jayce’s Restaurant
- Scuttlebutts Restaurant
- JR Remanufacturing
- Six Star Grocery
- Mennonite Central Committee
