

SASKATCHEWAN DAY August 7 2023

The 'Free Parking' Lot (empty corner lot fronting Herbert Avenue & Dennis Street) is off limits for parade parking this year. The lot is reserved for CAR SHOW participants only!

Please observe cones & barricades blocking direct access to the lot. Do not attempt to drive around them; you will be asked to park elsewhere. Signage will direct car show people to the appropriate parking areas.

Ensure all parked vehicles are removed from Herbert Avenue by 10 a.m. prior to parade start time.

Street parking may resume on the 500 & 600 blocks. The 700 block will also be reserved for CAR SHOW participants.

BUILDING PERMITS

This concerns any homeowner that may be planning a project that involves building, moving or demolishing a structure on any property. In fact, there are now very few projects that don't require a permit. The only exceptions are fence installations, or adding an accessory building 100 sq. ft. or less. Even then, a property owner must know where the property lines are in order to follow prescribed setbacks according to Zoning Bylaw 89-6, when determining the location of said structures.

If you are considering any sort of building project, it's imperative that you visit the Town office well in advance. The permit process takes time, at least two weeks in some cases. Permits are never approved the same day as submission, especially if council approval is required for a specific proposal beforehand.

A request for an appointment is to be made with the CAO in order to fill out the appropriate forms pertaining to the proposed project. Any questions regarding the process can be addressed at this time. The administration fee for this service is \$25.00.

Once all information has been acquired, the permit package is submitted to the Town's Building Inspector who in turn oversees that the project is compliant with the National Building Code; after which an invoice is issued to the homeowner for the plan review, inspections & mileage costs. The rates are solely based on the Building Inspector's fee schedule.

WATER BILL INCREASE

The August water billing for the July 1 - 31 billing period will see an overall increase from \$115.50 to \$118.00/month for both residential & commercial. The water rates will now be:
